
make sure all the information is accurate, but I expect I have made at least one mistake somewhere! Please bear with me – I'm new at this.





TUNE OF THE SEASON #1

I intend to include a tune in every issue as a point of interest for any musicians who feel they would like to stamp their identity on it. This is a traditional tune from Ireland which has been around for a long time, but slipped out of vogue, and in my opinion deserves an airing. The tune has a G Major key signature but it is actually in the key of D in Mixolydian or Soh mode, which is the scale of D with a flattened 7th. ie. D, E, F#, G, A, B, C, D. Chords are included. This is normally played as a slow march but it sounds really good with the pace picked up a bit too. It would be great to see efforts uploaded on YouTube as Folk in Cornwall TOTS#1; all instruments and abilities would be viewed with interest.
